APPROVE MINUTES: Scott motioned to approve the August minutes. Sarah seconded. All voted in favor.

CODIFYING ORDINANCES: Shannon Ellsworth with Sunrise Engineering joined our meeting via FaceTime. The council just wanted to clarify a few things about having our ordinances codified. She will digitize, re-work, and review to make sure the ordinances comply with state law. That should take about one month. After that, she will give everything to the council to review and make changes. We will need to hold a workshop to review the draft. She will get engineering help to change our subdivision and building permit ordinance. She will send a work order for us to sign.

HAL CHUGG BUILDING PERMIT:

Ryan made a motion to approve a building permit for a shed for Hal Chugg contingent on approval from Randy Henrie. Scott seconded and the motion passed.

WATER PROJECT UPDATE:

Steven Wood gave a water project update. They hope to go out to bid for the new well house on Monday. He gave out plans for the council to look over. He also let the council know that there are two line items relating to easement and property acquisition that are not going to be used. We could use it to pay off the loan faster or put it towards another project like GIS Mapping or looping the system.

KEY-LIX:

Steven Wood talked to Jed Archibald with Key-Lix. The location they were proposing to put their new building would be too expensive to put in the infrastructure for the water so they will have to look at other alternatives.

BRENT WEBB:

Brent asked if the city would be interested in renting their water shares next year because he would be interested in renting them. The council is considering putting in a system to use their shares but if not, they will put the shares out for bid to rent in the spring.

BARRIER PLACING AT INTERSECTION OF 1ST S AND 2ND E:

Four 2500 blocks will be put up with reflective tape at the intersection of 1st S and 2nd E to keep people from driving on the right side of the stop sign.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

- Mayor Garner read a letter from DEQ approving plans for the new transmission line.
- Mayor Garner shared a bid for an irrigation system to water the park with Weston Creek Irrigation shares.
- Mayor Garner shared a bid for tree trimming.
- The Covid 19 cases in Franklin County is 57. Idaho is averaging 250 cases per day.

AUGUST BILLS:

The bank statement and bills were passed around. Sarah motioned to approve the August bills. Ryan seconded and the motion passed.

DELINQUENT WATER BILL:

There were only three delinquent water bills. We will put a shut off notices on those three months past due.
