PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVE JULY MINUTES:

Travis motioned to approve the August minutes. Mark seconded. The motion passed.

JAXON OLSON GA-GA BALL PIT:

Ga-Ga Ball is a game played in a circular pit. Jaxon would like to build a pit for an Eagle Scout project. He could build it out of wood for about \$650 or out of trex for about \$1865. The council would like it built out of trex to last longer. He'd like to put it on the east side of the tennis court. He's going to try to get donations and a grant from Franklin County Medical Center but the council agreed to use money from the Mayor's Walking Challenge to cover what he doesn't get in donations or grants. He's planning on putting it in on October 30. The council is in support of this idea.

SINCLAIR DINOSAUR:

Van Woodward would like to put a Sinclair dinosaur at Woodward's store between the sidewalk and the curb in front of the gas pumps. The council looked at the proposed location and couldn't see any problems with it.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

-Glen has Gary Cahoon lined up to install new meters in Ben Gittin's subdivision.

-The trees on 1<sup>st</sup> East need to be trimmed. Glen got a bid from D's Trees for \$2000. The council asked that he get at least one other bid. They suggested Huntin' Timber.

WATER PROJECT UPDATE:

-Sharon read a letter from Steven Wood about the water project. The city was approved for their water rights transfer. Jay has 14 days to appeal the ruling. Steven is working on getting the well driller scheduled.

-Mayor Garner would like to make it clear that the homeowner's wells will not be continually tested to check if our new well has any impact on them. The city will do it's due diligence and check them before and after we drill the new well but there are too many variables each year that can affect the level of their wells besides the city's well.

CITY REMODEL AND CLEANUP:

- Travis will have an asbestos inspection done.
- We need to clean out the city office as much as possible and dispose of things that aren't usable.

DELINQUENT WATER BILLS:

Sharon will have Glen put shut off notices on those 3 months past due.

APPROVE AUGUST BILLS:

The council passed around the August bills and bank statement. Ryan motioned to approve the bills and Sarah seconded. Voting was all in favor.

Mark motioned to adjourn the meeting. Travis seconded. The meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
