PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

APPROVE MINUTES: Scott motioned to approve the September minutes and the August budget hearing minutes. Ryan seconded. All voted in favor.

WATER PROJECT UPDATE:

There will be a walk-through tomorrow with contractors who are going to be bidding on the project.

BUILDING PERMITS:

-Ben Gittins asked for a building permit to build a hay barn. It's a pre-engineered building. Travis motioned to approve Ben Gittin's building permit and Sarah seconded. All voted in favor.

-Travis Johnson asked for a building permit to build on lot 1 in the West Side View Subdivision. Ryan motioned to approve his permit and Scott seconded. Sarah voted in favor.

WESTON CREEK IRRIGATION EASEMENT MOVING:

Tyson Schvaneveldt was representing the Creek company and asked that their easement be moved a few hundred feet to the north. Currently it's south of Scott Buttar's house and they want it moved north between Buttar's house and Seamon's house so they can go east directly to Jacobson's. The council had no objections. They will defer voting on it until the November meeting.

JUNE ASTON WATER SHARES:

June told the council that she has paid the city's assessment in the past to use the city's water shares. She would still like to use the shares next year. The council told her that they will have some sort of sealed bid system to make it fair for anyone who wants to use them to be able to bid on them for next year if the city doesn't use them.

MAYOR'S REPORT:

-Mayor Garner has started the Mayor's walking challenge.

-Coronavirus is picking up more in the county.

PARK SPRINKLERS:

-Glen has recommended that the system he got a bid for to use the city's irrigation water shares in the park will not be cost effective. It would cost about \$25,000 and he doesn't believe there will be enough water pressure to run it. There is not unlimited water and we would still be on turns.

CODIFYING ORDINANCES:

Shannon Ellsworth is still working on the ordinances.

FISCAL YEAR BUDGET REVIEW:

Both the general and water budgets ended the year under budget.

APPROVE BILLS:

Travis motioned to approve the September bills. Sarah seconded. Voting was in favor.

DELINQUENT WATER BILLS:

Notices will be given to those 3 months late that their water will be shut off.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

-Kyle Henderson clarified a few points about the water walk-through.

-Scott asked if we would do Santa Claus this year because of coronavirus and Mayor Garner said to come with ideas for the November meeting about what we should do.

-Ryan has been asked that the city consider paving the road on first south from the railroad tracks up to where it turns to second south. There may be grants available to help with this.

Sarah motioned to adjourn the meeting. Ryan seconded. The meeting adjourned at 8:22 p.m.
